

Times to remember

20 and 50 minutes past each hour - Truro and Falmouth*
04 and 34 minutes past each hour - Penryn*

* Trains run at slightly different times early in the morning, at peak commuting times and after 18.30.

During most of the day, six days a week, trains leave Truro and Falmouth Docks stations at 20 and 50 minutes past each hour, passing at Penryn (34 and 04 minutes past each hour). All trains call at Penmere and Falmouth Town stations.

Perranwell has a train every 30 minutes in both directions during the morning and evening peak periods. At other times, the station has an hourly service. Perranwell is a request stop.

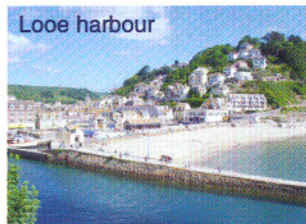
Great days out

Looe

Looe is a fascinating seaside resort and fishing port in South East Cornwall. As well as its fine sandy beach, this attractive town has a maze of alleyways and back streets to explore.

The journey from Falmouth takes around two hours and is a big part of the day out in its own right, as the journey includes a trip on the scenic Looe Valley Line.

Off Peak Day Return fare from Falmouth is £9.00.



St Ives

The best way to arrive in St Ives is by train. Soak up the dramatic views on the St Ives Bay Line from St Erth as the line sweeps alongside the golden sands of Hayle Towans, then hugs the cliffs as it passes through Carbis Bay and on to St Ives itself.

Porthminster Beach is right by the station while the town centre and picturesque harbour are just a short walk away.

Off Peak Day Return fare from Falmouth is £6.90.
